

## Examination System Academic Planning 2017-18

### Primary Department (I-V)

As per the guidelines issued by C.B.S.E., the school is implementing Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (C.C.E.). The objective of implementing C.C.E. is to facilitate holistic learning in a stress-free environment in the school. C.C.E. focuses at identifying the talents of the learner and to empower him/her with positive inputs.

**Classes (I and II):** Students will be awarded grades on the basis of their performance in the class rooms. The assessments will be done independently in three Terms.

Term I	April'15-August'15
Term II	September'15-December'15
Term III	January'16-March'16

**Classes (III-V):** The assessment and evaluation during the academic session will be done independently In three terms.

Term I	April'15-August'15
Term II	September'15-December'15
Term III	January'16-March'16

Assessment in the subjects will be done on the basis of Oral tests / Projects / Models / Activities conducted both formally and informally (without prior intimation and during class-room teaching-learning process).

Reading & Listening skills of Language and Class Performance (notebook maintenance and class room interaction) of the subjects will be tested informally during each Term. Evaluation will be done on the basis of cycle tests conducted during each Term.

The assessment and evaluation done during each term will be converted into grades based on 5-point scale as given below:

90% - 100%	A*	Outstanding
75% - 89%	A	Excellent
56% - 74%	B	Very Good
35% - 55%	C	Good
Below 35%	D	Scope for Improvement

The students will also be assessed on the basis of their performances in co-scholastic areas (Art, Dance, Music, Good reading and Computers) on 5-point scale as mentioned above. Achievement record of the student shall be given at the end of each term. Students will be assessed for General Awareness during all the Terms.  
Important Note

The Evaluation of the students of classes I to V is done according to the C.C.E guidelines given by the C.B.S.E.

1. There are 3 evaluations in one academic year.

2. It is mandatory for all students to appear for all the evaluations. However in case of serious illness it is advisable that the students take medical leave.
3. If an evaluation day is declared a holiday, the next working day will automatically be the evaluation day for that particular subject.
