### A BRIEF ANNUAL PEDAGOGICAL PLAN

In pursuance to the Circular No.ACAD-15/2019 dated 09 Mar, 2019, the Annual Pedagogical Plan (2019-20) was briefed by the Principal to the members. It was stated that there is a focus on integrating Art, Sports and ICT on to the existing curriculum and use active and experiential learning methods in the class room. Authentic learning tasks and activities have been included in the curriculum. A lot of emphasis has been placed on Art, Music, Dance Drama, Storytelling and Craft. Innovative ideas for contemporary teaching in the class rooms have been introduced by the school staff.

### **CLASS ROOM OBSERVATION:**

- In April: The teachers teaching methodology was inspected in the month of April, May & November by Principal.
- <u>In July:</u> On 22nd and 23rd July 2019, A team of **Subject Experts from CES** observed the teaching methodology of the staff. The Expert Panel comprising Mr. Suraj Prakash, Director, BBPS-Training Centre (Maths & Science), Ms. Rekha Sharma, Advisor-CES (English & Social Studies) and Ms. Nanu Rekhi, Advisor (Pre-Primary) observed the teaching pedagogies. Pre-Primary. Suggestions were made for further improvement to make teaching more effective in the Classroom.

A few suggestions were made by the Secretary, SMC to popularize BBPS-Jharli in nearby areas were made:

- Innovative Practices to be implemented from 2020-2021.
- Under new pedagogy 'Artificial Intelligence' and 'Financial Literacy' subjects to be introduced in class IX from 2020-2021.
   Artificial Intelligence can be introduced even from classes VI to VIII for the new session (2020-21).
- A safety walk to be carried out in the school premises by PTA members frequently.

- Information about winners of Open Exams should be given to parents through whatsapp group. The same results are to be
  uploaded on school website and even in PPT's of SMCs.
- First two District Toppers should be facilitated in their locality and their pics to be publicized on banners at the time of admission campaign.
- Orientation session for the parents of 10 rural girls admitted under CSE should be organised by the school on an immediate basis
