The kids had real fun time on their visit to the Plant Nursery along with their friends, teachers and Principal Sir in the month of April. The walk in the colorful world broadened their knowledge. 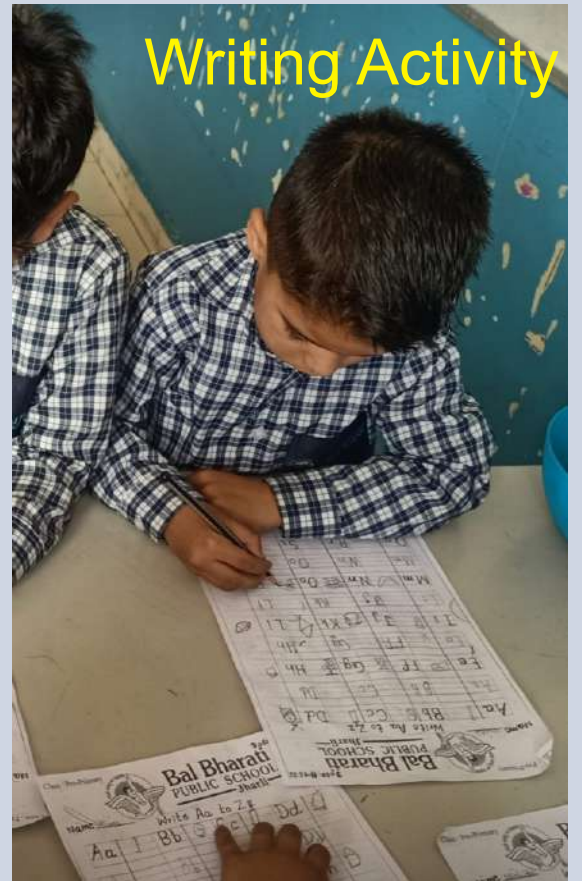

Hands-on learning is particularly important for young children, as this is how they are programmed to learn. Children learn from observing, doing and experimenting with their hands and body as soon as they are born, and play continues to be the most important way of learning new skills until they reach school age and beyond. To give the hands-on experiences and make learning more fun and engaging various activities were conducted for the Pre-primary classes. These activities included- band making, summer delight-colouring activity, storytelling- puppet show, create a peacock by hand impression, vegetable printing in circle shape and clay modeling. It was a pleasure to see the excitement of the tiny tots while engaging in these activities and gave a fun-learning experience for them.



Using real life context is a very important strategy and an effective way of motivating young learners. Children grasp ideas more easily and effectively and maintain their interest in school when their learning is connected to the world around them. To bring in real life learning in teaching the tiny tots were taken for a ‘Tour around my School’. In this activity the students were taken around to visit the different rooms and labs in the school. While observing these rooms they were trained to ask questions about various things they saw and what are they used for. The super excitement was seen on their faces when they visited the Principal’s office and were embraced by sir and distributed candies.
