








Dusshera was celebrated on October 1, 2022 to mark the victory of good over evil, our culture and glorious heritage.

POCSO WORKSHOP

(For Teachers)



To ensure the safety of the students and create awareness about sexual assault and sexual Bal Bharati Public School, Jharli harassment, organized an awareness workshop on 'Protection of Children from Sexual Offenses Act' (POCSO) on 19th November, 2022. The objective of the workshop was to spread awareness about child sexual abuse and the POCSO Act. It was conducted by Mr. Sanjeev Godara, a legal advisor at the Dadri court, who spoke at length about the prevalence of child abuse in our society and emphasized on the importance of identifying the signs that may lead to behaviour change in students (Society Circles in relation to mental or physical abuse). He reiterated the importance of the role played by teachers in the safety and security of children. The teachers were also sensitized about the various acts of sexual harassment which are often overlooked and the workshop provided information to all the teachers such as how to deal with various topics of sexuality; preventive steps to be taken; Identifying signs of abuse and relevance of POCSO Act.






