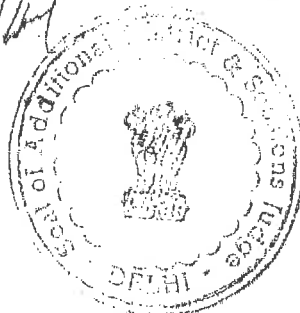
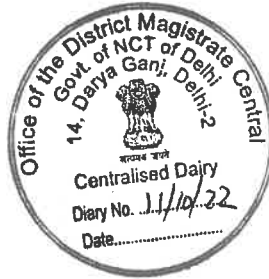
1. The name of the Society shall be "CHILD EDUCATION SOCIETY".
2. The office of the Society shall be situated at Delhi.
3. The objects for which the Society is established are :-

A. MAIN OBJECTS:

The Society shall exist solely for educational purposes and not for the purpose of profit.

B. OTHER OBJECTS :

- a) To advance, promote, impart, cultivate, improve, help, disseminate and encourage generally amongst students of the Indian Community throughout the world, the study of and education in all kinds of subjects including literary, commercial, physical, moral, scientific, technical, industrial & cultural subjects and also fine arts and in such subjects which will help or promote diffusion of useful knowledge.

- b) To co-operate with Universities and Educational or other Institutions in any part of the world having objects wholly or partly similar to those of the Society by inviting and sending out teachers, scholars and generally in such manner as may be conducive to their common objectives.
- c) No income of the Society shall be applied outside India without the approval of the Government of India.

4. For and in connection with the furtherance of its objects or any of them the Society shall have power:-

- a) To establish acquire, take over, carry on and maintain in affiliation or otherwise colleges, schools, classes and teaching or training institutions of any description literary, scientific or technical, peripatetic or permanently located definitely or for a limited period and to dissolve, give up, disaffiliate or cease to carry on all or any of them.
- b) To hold examinations and to grant certificates of proficiency and other academic distinctions or titles to persons who comply with the conditions laid down in the regulations or bye-laws of the Society.
- c) To institute and appoint persons to Professorship, Readership, Lecturership, Fellowship and Chairs on posts of any description.
- d) To invest the funds of the Society in any securities including deposits in banks and other institutions and to call in or vary such investments from time to time.
- e) To accept gifts, donations, benefactions or to borrow or otherwise raise money with or without security or by mortgage or any of the properties of the Society or otherwise or by the issue of bonds debentures or credit instruments of any description for achieving the educational purposes of the Society.
- f) To purchase, take on lease or otherwise acquire and to construct buildings for housing educational institutions and hostels for students.
- g) To provide facilities for giving residential accommodations and boarding houses for teachers, staff and students and other persons engaged in carrying out any of the objects of the Society.
- h) To give scholarship, stipends, prizes and modals and also to make any other arrangements of the education of needy and deserving students.
- i) To found and or maintain libraries or reading rooms for general use among the members of public museums and galleries of painting and other works of art, collections of natural history, mechanical inventions, instruments or designs.
- j) To frame schemes, regulations or bye-laws and to alter, modify or rescind the same.
- k) To alter, vary, change or modify the objects of the Society if sanctioned by a meeting of the members of the Society.
- l) To do all such things as may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of all Society or any of them.

5. The following persons shall constitute the First Board of Trustees for the Management of the affairs of the Society :-

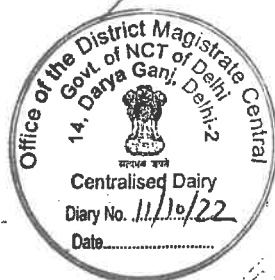

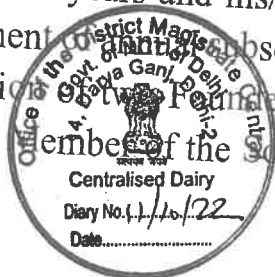

RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE CHILD EDUCATION SOCIETY

1. The members may belong to any of the following classes: Founder Members, Life Members, Ordinary Members and Honorary Members which will comprise the General Body of the Society.
2. Any Indian citizen, not being a minor who is competent to contract under the applicable provisions of the Indian Contract Act 1872, is eligible for Founder Membership by paying Rs 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh) or more provided his/her name is sponsored by minimum two existing Founder Members and minimum 3/4th majority of the existing Founder Members support the application. In case of death or voluntary retirement of any Founder Member eldest amongst his/her heirs/legal representative shall be eligible for Founder Member on a payment of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand).
3. Any Indian citizen, not being a minor who is competent to contract under the applicable provisions of the Indian Contract Act 1872, is eligible for Life Membership by paying Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) or more provided his/her name is sponsored by minimum two existing Founder/Life Members and minimum 3/4th majority of the existing members (Founder/Life) support the application. Life Members shall hold office for his/her life only. Any Life Member shall be subject to removal from his/her office, by the decision of the majority of other members of the Society. On recommendation of two Founder Members, the President may appoint/enroll the first Life Member of the Society on payment of onetime Membership Fee of Rs. 25,000 (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only). The appointment/enrolment of Life Member shall be intimated to the Board of Management.
4. Any Indian citizen, not being a minor who is competent to contract under the applicable provisions of the Indian Contract Act 1872, can apply for Ordinary Membership by paying Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) or more provided his/her name is sponsored by minimum two existing Founder/Life/Ordinary Members and minimum 3/4th majority of the existing members (Life, Founder and Ordinary) support the application. Any Ordinary Member shall hold the office for a period of three years and his/her membership can be renewed on year to year basis on payment of subscription of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand). On recommendation of two Founder Members, the President may appoint/enroll the first Ordinary Member of the Society on payment of onetime Membership Fee of

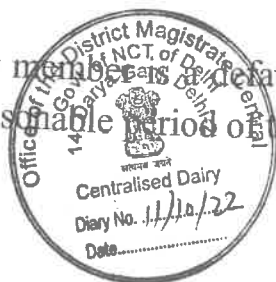
Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only). The appointment/enrolment of Ordinary Member shall be intimated to the Board of Management.

5. Any Indian citizen, not being a minor who is competent to contract under the applicable provisions of the Indian Contract Act 1872, and who has rendered eminent service to the Society or who on account of his education or position or for any other reason is in a position to render valuable assistance and advice and/or whose association with the Society is considered to be desirable or beneficial may be co-opted as an Honorary member of the Society for a period of three years.
6. A person intending to become a member of the Society shall make an application to the Honorary Secretary in the prescribed form. It shall be accompanied by the lumpsum payment(s) as aforementioned. The Honorary Secretary will place the application before the Board of Management. The amount deposited will be refunded if the application is rejected by the Board of Management. The applicant whose application has been rejected may reapply after a period of two (2) years.

7. Termination/Cancellation of Membership

The membership may terminate on the occurrence of the following contingencies:

- i.) If a member is found to be a lunatic by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction or becomes of unsound mind.
- ii.) If a member is convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude and punishable under Indian Penal Code or any other law for the time being in force.
- iii.) If a member resigns his office by giving two months' notice addressed to the President unless such notice is withdrawn in writing prior to the date from which such notice is to take effect.
- iv.) If any member is found involved in any serious misappropriation of funds belonging to the Society.
- v.) If any ordinary member is a defaulter in making payment of the membership fee within a reasonable period of time.



- vi.) If the general body by 3/4th majority are of the opinion that it will be harmful to the Society to keep any particular person as a member.

8. Board of Management

All properties of the Society, movable and immovable, shall remain vested in the Board of Management and the affairs of the Society shall be conducted, controlled, governed and supervised by the Board of Management, who shall have full power to do all that may be necessary or desirable to give effect to the objects of the Society and generally to exercise all its powers to carry out its functions.

Composition of the Board of Management

The Board of Management will comprise of the President, Vice-President, Secretary and minimum of three members, who will be elected by the General Body from amongst the Founder Members, Life Members and Ordinary Members for a period of three years. Joint Secretary, if any, when coopted will also be a member of the Board of Management.

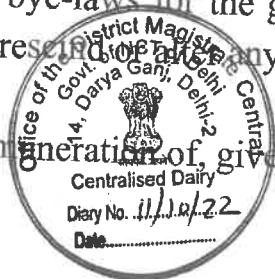
Term of office of the Board of Management:

The term of office of the Board of Management shall be for a period of three years.

Powers & Functions of the Board of Management:

In addition to and without restricting the generality of the powers provided in the Memorandum of Association, the Board of Management shall have powers: -

- a. To frame, alter, vary or rescind these regulations.
- b. To establish, affiliate or maintain or dissolve educational institution(s) or any of them and to determine from time to time the educational programme of the Society and to make all necessary steps to give effect thereto.
- c. To make or sanction bye-laws for the guidance of any of the institutions of the Society and to add to rescind or alter any such bye-laws.
- d. To appoint, fix the remuneration of, give or withhold leave, to suspend or dismiss all employees.



- e. To enter into any co-operative arrangement or concerted action and to refer any matter to arbitration.
- f. The forms and mode of investment or deposits by the society will be as per the provisions of Income Tax Act 1961, as amended from time to time in compliance with the mandatory provisions and to avail general income tax exemptions.
- g. To incur all necessary expenditure on behalf of the Society.
- h. To enter into any other transaction authorized by the Memorandum and Rules and Regulations of the Society for effectively running the educational institutions and to recover any fee or other sums due from any person either by suit or otherwise.
- i. To raise and borrow money in accordance with the powers of the Society and to mortgage or hypothecate a property, movable or immovable for the purpose thereof.
- j. To accept benefactions on such terms and conditions as it may think it fit.
- k. To delegate all or any of its powers to persons, boards or councils composed of its own members or other members of the Society.
- l. To open an account or accounts in any bank or Banks in the name of the Society or of any of institutions, schools or colleges operating under its aegis and to authorize any two or more of the members to operate such accounts and endorse sign, draw and deal with securities, hundis, bills and other documents.
- m. To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the members) as Governor or Committee men for the purpose of discharging such objects in connection with the Society and for management of the funds belonging to the Society or otherwise in relation to the carrying out of the objects of the Society, subject to such regulations as the Board of Management may from time to time prescribe.
- n. To appoint or provide for the appointment of separate members to hold any hereditaments or properties acquired or any building fund or endowment fund formed or any other properties, investments or funds at any time subject to such

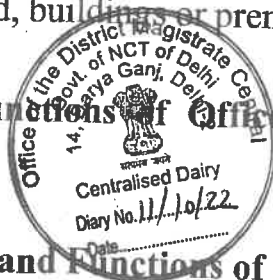


rules and regulations or powers and in such manner as the Board of Management may from time to time frame or confer and to delegate to one or more of such members or governors or to any committee or separate members any of the powers vested in the Board of Management.

- o. To make provision for the management and control of any of the institutions, schools or colleges connected with the Society and also to appoint and make provisions for the appointment of any persons (including all or any of the members) as Committee Men or Governing Body or Inspecting Body or otherwise for the purpose of managing the said institutions, schools or colleges or the affairs thereof in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as may be prescribed.
- p. To make or frame, from time to time, repeal, vary, alter or amend schemes, rules and regulations pertaining to the management and conduct of the affairs of any institution, college or school connected with the Society and as to the conduct of business by any Committee or Sub-Committee or as to any manner connected therewith.
- q. To make any investments in accordance with the powers of the Society and to be in accordance with the provisions of any statute in force applicable to the Society from time to time.
- r. To expand the funds of the Society in such manner as they shall consider most beneficial for the purpose of the Society or in the name of the institutions, schools or colleges, such part thereof as they deem fit or not immediately required for the purposes of the Society and to direct the sale or transposition of any such investment and to expand the proceeds of such sale for the purpose of the Society.
- s. To acquire in the name of the Society or in the name of the institutions, schools or colleges, build upon, pull down, rebuild and to alter, repair, improve, sell or dispose of or otherwise deal with any land, buildings or premises for the use of the Society.

9. Appointment, Powers and Functions of Office Bearers of The Board of Management

- a. Appointment/Election, Powers and Functions of The President



- (i) The President shall be elected by the Board of Management from amongst the Founder Members on the Board of Management for a term of three years.
- (ii) President shall be the presiding officer and shall preside at all the meetings.
- (iii) He /she shall be an Ex-Officio Member of any Committee or Sub- Committee constituted for any purpose by the Child Education Society.
- (iv) He/she shall have the power to exercise a casting vote in the event of a deadlock/equality of vote on any issue.

The President will be empowered to exercise the power(s) vested in any other office-bearer of the Board of Management in the event of non-availability of such office bearer on account of any reason whatsoever. At first instance, the power shall be available with the President for a period of Six (6) Months.

b) Appointment, Election, Powers and Functions of The Vice-President.

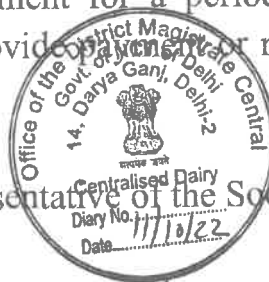
The Vice President shall be elected by the Board of Management from amongst the Founder Members on the Board of Management for a term of three years.

- (i) Vice President will preside all the meetings of the Board of Management in the absence of the President.
- (ii) He will also perform all the other duties of the President in his absence.

c) Appointment/Election, Powers and Functions of Honorary Secretary.

The Honorary Secretary of the Board of Management shall be elected from amongst the members of the Board of Management for a period of three years. The Board of Management may also decide to provide remuneration to the Secretary for his services.

- (i) He will act as Legal Representative of the Society.
- (ii) He will sign contracts, agreements and any other legal documents on behalf of the Society.

- (iii) He will call the General Body Meeting and the Board of Management Meeting and present the Accounts, Reports of the Society.
- (iv) He shall be the Ex-officio Member of any Committee or Sub Committee constituted by the Child Education Society for any specific purpose.

d) Appointment Power and Functions of The Joint Secretary.

The Joint Secretary shall be a co-opted member who will hold the office as a Joint Secretary for a term of three years.

The main function of the Joint Secretary is to assist in the affairs of the Society.

10. Quorum, Constitution and Term of Office of The Board of Management

- (a) 1/3rd (one/third) of the members of the Board of Management or three whichever is less.
- (b) The number of members on the Board of Management shall not at any time be more than Fourteen (14).

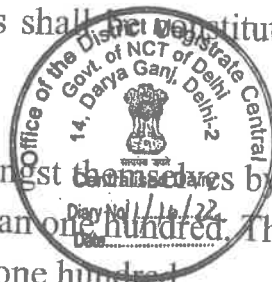
The following shall constitute the First Members, namely: -

1. Lala Hansraj Gupta, BANKER, 20, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi
2. Mr L N Birla, Banker, 8, Royal Exchange Place, Calcutta
3. Mr K K Birla, Banker, 8, Royal Exchange Place, Calcutta

(c) No person convicted under the Indian Penal Code or under other law of any offence involving moral turpitude shall be eligible to be appointed as a member.

(d) The First members shall hold office for one year from the date of registration of the Society under Society Registration Act xxi of 1860. Before the expiry of the said period a new Board of Members shall be constituted at the annual general meeting as follows:-

- (i) The Founder members shall from amongst themselves by a majority elect five (5) members if their total number is less than one hundred. They shall nominate six (6) members if their number is more than one hundred.



- (ii) The Life members shall from amongst themselves by a majority nominate four (4) members if their total number is less than one hundred. They shall nominate five (5) members if their number is more than one hundred.
- (iii) The ordinary members shall from amongst themselves by a majority nominate two (2) members if their total number is less than one hundred. They shall nominate three (3) members if their number is more than one hundred.
- (iv) The members nominated as aforesaid shall have power by majority to co-opt further two members {in addition to the Joint Secretary appointed as per Rule 9(d)} irrespective of their being members of the Society or not, for a period of three years.
- (e) The term(s) of the office of the new Board of Management shall commence on and from the date of expiry of the term(s) of office of the first members. Thereafter a new Board of Management shall be constituted in the like manner as aforesaid at every Third Annual General Meeting. On the constitution of the new Board, the old Board of Management shall retire.
- (f) A retiring member shall be eligible for renomination and shall act as a member through the duration of the meeting on the conclusion of which the said member was due to retire.
- (g) The members shall hold a general meeting at least once every year such that the gap between successive meetings will not exceed 15 (Fifteen Months).

11. Vacancy In the Office of A Member of The Board of Management

- (i) The office of a member of the Board of Management shall ipso facto be vacated:-
 - a) If such member is adjudged insolvent and fails to make payments or compounds with his/her creditors.
 - b) If such member is found to be a lunatic by a competent court or becomes of unsound mind.
 - c) If he/she is convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude and punishable under the Indian Penal Code or any other applicable law for the time being in force.



d) If he/she resigns his office by giving two months' notice in writing addressed to the Board of Management acting through the President /Secretary unless such notice is withdrawn in writing prior to the date on which such notice is to take effect.

(ii) The vacancy in the office of a member caused by death, retirement or otherwise shall be filled up by the continuing members. The member or members so elected shall be deemed to be a member or members as though originally appointed.

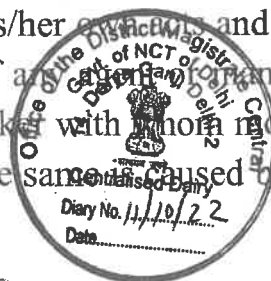
(iii) No person who has been adjudicated an insolvent and has not obtained his personal discharge shall be eligible to be appointed as a Member.

12. The President or any two members may at any time summon a special meeting for any cause that seems to him or them to be sufficient.

13. Notwithstanding any vacancy, the continuing members may act in their body, provided, however, that if the number falls below three the members shall not act save and except for the purpose of filling up the vacancy.

14. The members shall not receive remuneration of any kind or receive any money from the Society and or the trust estate directly or indirectly by way of remuneration or profit except when appointed as a paid Secretary. Any member may however be paid travelling and halting allowance if so resolved upon by the members. Provided nevertheless that if any member is called upon to render or perform professional services such member shall be entitled to be reasonably remunerated accordingly.

15. Every member shall be answerable for his/her acts and defaults only and not for those of any of his/her co-members or of any manager appointed under the power at their command, nor for any bank with whom money or securities may be deposited nor for any other loss unless the same is caused by his/her own willful act, omission or default.



16. The members shall keep proper books of accounts with respect to all moneys received and expended by them and of the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place and of the assets, credits and liabilities of the Society.

17. The members shall be entitled to frame Bye-Laws for regulation of their own procedures to conduct business, provided that 3 (Three) members shall form a quorum.

18. Annual General Meeting

a) The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held every year at such time and place as the Board of Management may decide, but atleast within fifteen months from the date of last Annual General Meeting.

b) At least one month before the Annual General Meeting at which the members are to be elected the Secretary of the Society shall send intimation to the members of the Society inviting nominations to the Board of Management, and for appointment of Auditors for the next ensuing year.

c) Each nomination should reach the Secretary of the Society at least ten (10) days before the Annual General Meeting. No proposal which reaches the Secretary after the time aforesaid will be considered/entertained by the Board of Management in the Annual General Meeting. Every nomination must be duly proposed and seconded.

d) Notices of the Annual and other General Meeting shall be given to the members at least fifteen days before such meetings.

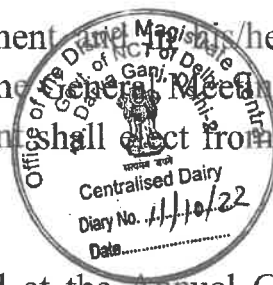
e) One third of the total number of Founder Members, Life Members and Ordinary Members, or ten (10), whichever is less, present in person at a General Meeting shall form a quorum.

f) If there be no quorum until the expiry of twenty minutes from the time for which the meeting has been called, General Meeting shall be adjourned subsequent to which the members present will form a quorum.

g) The President of the Board of Management or in his/her absence, one of the members by consensus, will preside over the General Meeting of the Society. In the absence of all of them the members present shall elect from amongst themselves a President for such meeting.

h) The following business will be transacted at the Annual General Meeting of the Society:

(i) To pass the annual report and the audited accounts



- (ii) To pass the budget, if any, for the next year
- (iii) To elect the members and to appoint the auditors for the next year and
- (iv) To consider such matter, as may be deemed necessary, to be brought forward before the meeting.

- i) Every member of the Society present in person at the Annual General Meeting or any other General Meeting of the Society will have one vote. In case of an equality of votes, the President of the meeting will have a second or casting vote.
- j) Every matter or proposal brought forward before the meeting for consideration will be decided by a majority of the members present at such meeting and decision of the President of the meeting as to whether a resolution has been passed or lost unanimously or by a particular majority shall prevail and be final.
- k) One-fourth of total number of members of the Society or twenty-five (25) members, whichever be less, will be entitled to send a requisition to the Secretary to call a General Meeting specifying the objects for the consideration of which the said meeting is to be called. On receipt of such requisition the Secretary shall call a General Meeting within a fortnight from the date of the receipt of such requisition. If the Secretary fails to call a meeting within the time aforesaid, the requisitionists will be entitled to call within a month from the date on which the meeting should have been convened a General Meeting at such time and place as they may consider. Proper notice whereof shall be given to the members of the Society at least seven days before the date of such meeting.
- l) In such extra ordinary General Meetings only such matters will be considered of which notice has been given.

19. The following additions have been made by utilizing the Powers granted to Board of Management under Clause 8(a) as Rules & Regulations.

- i. One member from the office of the Joint District Registrar would be included in the Managing Committee of Bal Bharati Public School, Sector-21, Noida.
- ii. 10% seats would be reserved for SC/ST and these children would be charged concessional fee.
- iii. Bal Bharati Public School, Noida shall not claim any aid whatsoever from the Government of Uttar Pradesh.
- iv. The staff employed by Bal Bharati Public School, Noida would be given scale of pay, allowances and benefits as are applicable to Central Government employees.



- v. Any order received from time to time from the State Government would be duly implemented within the framework of law.
- vi. The school is maintaining and shall maintain the records properly.

20. Alterations of Rules

The general Rules and Regulations of the Society can be altered in any General Meeting of the Society by a majority of a minimum of 2/3rd of the members present at such meeting.

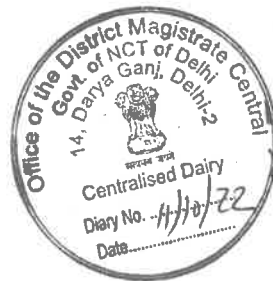
21. Notice

Any accidental omission to send any notice or non-receipt of any notice by any member shall not invalidate the proceedings of any meeting.

22. The income and property of the Society shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society. If any donor limits his donation or contribution to any particular object or objects or earmarks the same, it shall be spent towards the promotion of that particular object or objects only.

23. Winding Up

If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Society there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Society but shall be given or transferred to some other institution or institutions having similar objects of the Society to be determined by the members of the Society at or before the time of the winding up, or dissolve in accordance with the provisions of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.
