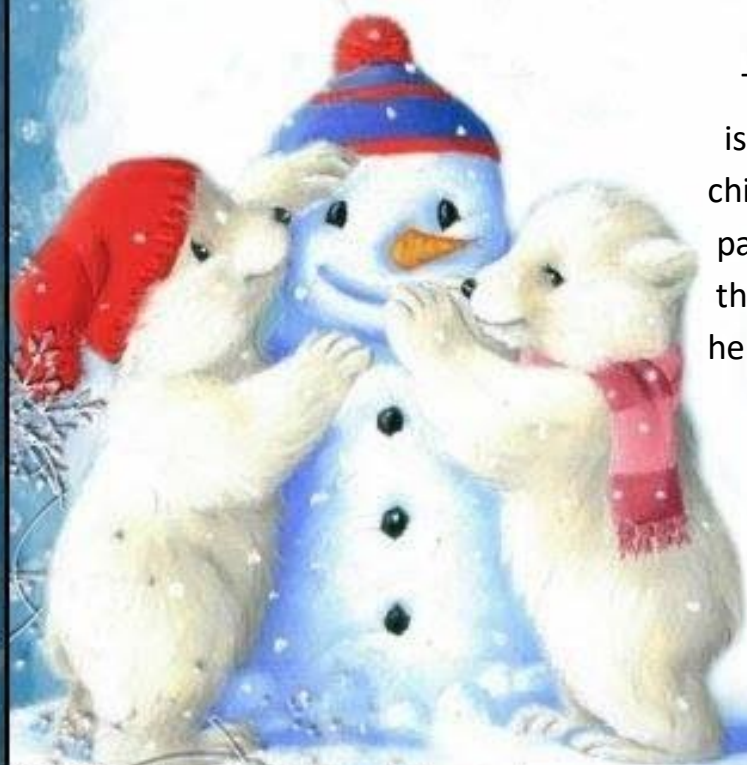
1. Fairy Tales
