

INCENTIVE SCHEME FOR SPECIAL ACHIEVERS IN SPORTS & GAMES

The purpose of providing an Incentive Scheme for meritorious students in sports needs consideration of the rankings of each child from Sub-Junior, Junior and Senior categories, as well as participation in tournaments of recognized associations and federations.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > The Scheme applies to all students enrolled with Bal Bharati Public Schools.
- The Sports Incentive Scheme can be availed for one academic session based on the performance of sports athletes in the previous academic session.
- Achievements must be recognized by the relevant National or State Sports Associations/Federations or recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
- The extension of incentive scheme for subsequent academic session(s) is subject to reassessment of performance of the sports athletes.
- > The Sports incentive scheme can be availed for Team Event(s) and Individual event(s).
- The sports athletes must maintain a minimum academic performance as defined by the school.
- The sports athletes must uphold discipline and sportsmanship in all school and sports activities.
- The sports athletes must not have any disciplinary records that contradict the school's values.
- Verification of certificates and participation records will be mandatory before approving any incentive. The incentive will not be sanctioned if any inconsistency or misrepresentation is identified during the verification process.

PROCESS OF AVAILING SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

- Sports Athletes need to submit their achievement documents to the School Principal on a prescribed format and within a time schedule as decided by the school Principal.
- Evaluation of the submitted documents will be done by the Scholarship Panel of respective schools.
- Incentives for New Admissions will be evaluated based on their performance during their previous year, provided all necessary documents have been submitted.

SCHOLARSHIP PANEL

The recommended constitution of Scholarship Panel/Senior Accounts Officer is Vice Principal/Headmistress as convenor, Sports Director/Sports In-Charge/HoD Physical Education and two Senior Teachers nominated by the Principal.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Verification of Certificates and Achievements- The panel shall review and authenticate certificates, accolades and achievements submitted by the applicant for the last academic session
- Verification of Academic Results- The panel shall verify the applicant's academic performance and results of the last academic session.
- Assessment of Code of Conduct- The panel shall evaluate the applicant's discipline, behaviour, and adherence to the code of conduct for students, as defined by the school.
- Ensuring Maximum Benefit and Recognition- The panel shall ensure maximum benefit and recognition to students, prioritizing the highest beneficiary accolade in cases where a student holds multiple accolades in the previous academic session.
- Grievance Redressal The panel members will also be the members of Sports Grievance Redressal Committee. They will deliberate on the concerns raised by students/parents related to sports incentives, will check the relevant documents & facts and will recommend necessary action to the Principal who shall be the chairperson of the Sports Grievance Redressal Committee.

OUTSTANDING PLAYERS OF EWS/DG/CWSN/STAFF CATEGORY -

For the outstanding players of EWS/DG/CWSN/Staff category, Rs. 2,500/- per month to be sanctioned towards nutritional enhancements.

NON MONETARY BENEFITS FOR OUTSTANDING PLAYERS -

The outstanding players of International/National/State level may be granted nonmonetary benefits as decided by the Head of School. The same may be extended to achievers of Zonal & District level Competitions as encouragement to upcoming talent.

- Issuance of Appreciation letters
- Recognition in school assembly
- Appreciation posts on school the website, official social media pages, class WhatsApp groups
- Featuring achievements in school publications
- > Awards on Annual Days for achievers as well as upcoming talent.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT -

The school will recognize the efforts of the Sports students who hold national positions by offering academic support. The support includes extra tutoring and accommodation for missed classes or assessments due to sports commitments.

- Counselling sessions for parents as well as students to encourage a balanced approach to education and sports, enabling students to pursue both without compromising for parents as well as students.
- Considering players 'on duty' for attendance during the period for which the student is attending training camp or is participating in any competition sponsored/sanctioned by the school.

OTHER ALLOWANCES PERMISSIBLE FOR SPORTS TEAMS

- School team or the individual player and the Coach/Manager travelling with team participating in a recognized international tournament in any part of the world shall be entitled to Air Travel (Economy class) concession up to 50%. A student may avail the international travel concession up to a maximum of two tournaments per year. The Tournaments must be recognized by the relevant National or State Sports Associations/Federations or recognized and funded by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
- Team participating in any competition outside Delhi/NCR in a recognized competition shall be entitled to travel by AC 3-tier train/chair car including Shatabdi and Rajdhani. Team Manager/Coach/Parent travelling with the team shall also be eligible for a three-tier AC train/chair car fair. School shall bear all expenses. *In case the school wishes to send team by Air, 50% expenditure will be borne by school.*
- Team members including Coach / Teacher / Manager shall be entitled for refreshment -Rs. 100/per head, (maximum) participating in any local recognized sports competitions, sponsored by the school.
- In exceptional cases, where lodging and boarding in CBSE Schools is unsatisfactory, a sum of Rs. 1000/- per player per night will be permissible.
- Rs. 500/- per day per person is allowed for food & refreshments for outstation recognized tournaments.
- Notwithstanding any of the above, in exceptional cases, the school may sanction an additional amount to any outstanding player/team to facilitate participation in a recognized tournament.
- Prior approval for all aforesaid expenditure from the Secretary and Chairman of the School is mandatory.
